
PLACEMENTS @ MKcity

MANAV KALYAN SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

The Manav Kalyan Charitable Trust and its promoters have been passionate about extending the benefit of their endeavors to all deserving students irrespective of their social or economic background.

Objective

The objective is to recognize and reward excellence by offering scholarships to students who secure admission to the Institute runs under Manav Kalyan Charitable Trust, based on their academic performance, Economic Background and Physical status.

Eligibility & Selection

The Scheme is implemented under three criteria viz. 1) Academic Performance (Merit) 2) Economical Background 3) Physical Disability. The Eligibility and Selection for these criteria are as follows.

- 1) Academic Performance (Merit):** - Students who secure not less than 75% marks in the qualifying examination will be eligible to apply for a merit scholarship. The scholarship amount will depend upon the percentage secure in qualifying examination.
- 2) Economical Background:** - Students with poor Economical Background having annual family income not more than 2,00,000/- and securing minimum 50% marks in qualifying examination are eligible for this Scholarship. The scholarship amount will depend upon the annual family income.
- 3) Physical Disability:** - Students with Physical Disability 40% or more and securing minimum 50% marks in qualifying examination are eligible for this Scholarship.

General Terms and Conditions: -

- The grant of scholarship will be subject to the applicant securing admission to the Institute runs under Manav Kalyan Charitable Trust at Manav Knowledge city
- The amount grant as a scholarship will be determined by the management and will be notified before the completion of admission process
- The award of scholarship will be restricted to the number of scholarships approved for that academic year.
- The awardee will be designated as Mkcite Scholar during the tenure of the scholarship.
- Generally, 25% to 30% of the sanctioned seats in each stream will be earmarked for award of scholarship.
- The scholarship amount will be deducted from the fees to pay the respective institute.
- Misconduct, misbehavior or any kind of indiscipline may result in cancelation of partial or full scholarship at any time
- The benefits of scholarship may be withdrawn for previous years in case of cancelation of admission during the coursework as scholarship is awarded to complete the course for which admission is taken.

Documents Required

Documents required to avail Manav Kalyan Scholarship Scheme depending upon category are:

1. Qualifying Examination Marksheet
2. Certified documents showing annual family income
3. Disability Certificate indicating 40% Disability



INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES

SEMINAR HALL

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMMUNICATION LAB

CAFETERIA



DISCIPLINE

CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

EVALUATION SYSTEM

Internal assessment marks are based on two class tests, journals, viva voce and performance. Apart from the end term examinations, we follow a system of continuous evaluation for assessment of student performance.
